Marjorie is a business administrator and entrepreneur with decades of experience working with nonprofits and businesses big and small throughout Florida. She has owned a local construction company, and while in Florida a publishing company and advertising firms.

A native of Baltimore and University of Maryland alumna started her career with

Bendix Corporation, working on the Apollo Space Program with their Field Engineering Division jointly working with NASA in Beltsville, Maryland. Graduating to the Bendix corporate marketing division in Southfield, Michigan, she relocated to corporate marketing positions with Dresser Industries in Dallas, Texas and Blue Cross-Blue Shield in Jacksonville, Florida.

Active as a non-profit marketing director and fund raiser in St. Petersburg, FL, she moved to non-profit administration while serving as the deputy director of the Palm Beach County Cultural Council. Having lived in Atlanta for a number of years, I got to know several Delta pilots, but **American Airlines Captain Mike Cariello's** journey from a nearly homeless high school student to Top Gun instructor is about the most interesting I have come across. After the loss of his mother and a tough start in Bradenton high school, Mike attended Manatee Community College and then FSU. Mike signed up for the Navy/Marine Corps aviation program and attended OCS at Quantico, VA. After earning his wings at Pensacola, Mike ultimately ended up as a Top Gun (Navy Fighter Weapons School) instructor for 3 years. After completing 13 years in the USMC, Mike then was involved in a special flight training program that almost cost him life with a crash landing in the Mohave Desert. After completely recovering, Mike joined American Airlines, where has worked as a pilot for 17 years, flying their international flights, currently out of Miami. Mike showed us how we can turn our lives around once we have a passion and a clear focus on what we want to do, no matter how challenging the circumstances are or how limited our opportunities appear.
