passionate about small business and local attractions working together to continue to make her home state the US's top tourist destination.

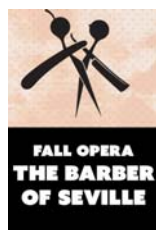

PREVIOUS MEETING (5/30/18) by Ron Rayevich

When I was a kid (and the Dinosaurs still roamed the earth) I used to watch the Friday Night Fights on TV every week with my uncle. We would usually bet a nickel on who the winner was going to be. **Harold Wilen, founder of the Sarasota Boxing Club**, brought back those evenings to me (now some 60 years ago), when professional boxing was fun to watch. Harold explained that he founded the Sarasota Boxing Club to provide an atmosphere of "love and Respect" and "A Safe Alternative to the Streets and Gangs" for Sarasota and Manatee County youth who want to get off the streets and develop their amateur boxing skills. Joining Harold was **Johnny "Ghetto Blaster" Williams**, told us how boxing had changed his life. In June, Johnny, now age 51, will be inducted into the Florida Boxing Hall of Fame. **Marty Hurwitz**, also joined Harold to discuss how the "Power of Expectations" can change our perceptions of ourselves and others in a competitive environment, and why we can be much more than we think we can be. Today's **Sarasota Boxing Club** is located at the corner of 15th Street and Lime Ave. near downtown Sarasota, having moved multiple times from their original location at Central Ave. and Blvd. of the Arts. (Now the new home for the Sarasota Ballet and Sarasota Opera performers). Thanks, **Harold**, for your devotion to a sport which can change young lives right here in Sarasota.
