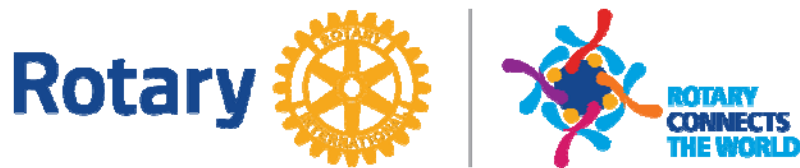

Lauren Rudd, a 40-year Wall Street veteran and, for the past 31 years, a syndicated columnist, presented a spirited and enlightening talk on the State of Wall Street and the strategies that he uses, personally, to choose what to invest in. While being sure to emphasize that all information was for entertainment purposes only, Lauren explained the benefit of a stocks-only portfolio, optimizing at just 15-20 well-researched companies over mixing bonds, mutual funds, etc., for long-term success. Each year he publishes a "List of 12" companies, noting that his list creates a portfolio that out-performs the S&P. Rudd spoke from the heart of a teacher, sharing his wisdom with enthusiasm and humor that had many club members taking notes (or photos of his slides).
